#### **Summary of the Event**

The speaker, Ms. Prathyusha Parakala has spoken about climate change and continued by several human actions that increase greenhouse gases in the atmosphere and accelerate greenhouse gases. And the reasons that are responsible for climate change by which terrestrial and aquatic environments are being affected by this climate change. She shared her experience about her journey to Antarctica, to understand Climate Change on the fragile ecosystem of Antarctica. After crossing some of the roughest seas in the world and travelling on the ship for more than 2 weeks, being on the expedition to the Last Great Wilderness Antarctica, gave her a firsthand experience of the impact we have had on our climate. This has helped her better understand the continent's fragile ecosystem & the effect of Climate Change on all life. It was a unique blend of leadership development and up-to-date education on climate change. Prathyusha is a lifelong member of Climate Force; a global network of leaders and am committed to spread this knowledge and a member of Al Gore's Climate Reality Network. She has used various platforms like TEDx, Josh Talks to raise awareness on climate change, sustainable lifestyle, and maximizing inner potential. I aim to inspire other women to take up such adventurous and meaningful journeys. Born in Hyderabad, lived across India and travelled a little around the world, Prathyusha has secured three Masters Degrees- Software Engineering (VIT, Vellore), Public Administration (IGNOU) and most recently in Environment, Development and Politics (2021) from University of Birmingham. She has also worked with COP 26 team on Race to Resilience and Race to Zero, to mobilize action from businesses and commit to ambitious, actionable climate goals. Prathyusha has worked with various NGOs on missions like Child Rights, Education, Environmental Awareness and Women Empowerment. She was a Fellow with Teach For India for two years teaching kids from under-

resourced communities. Prathyusha also worked as a Radio Jockey (RJ)
and used her influence to discuss Environment in the garb of entertainment.
